### Keynote Speaker: Rich Feller

Rich Feller, Ph.D. is Professor Emeritus of Counseling and Career Development and one of 12 University Distinguished Teaching Scholars at Colorado State University. He's served as the National Career Development Association (NCDA) President, consultant to NASA, the United Nations, the National Football League (NFL), AARP, and international and small organizations. Lead trainer for the JCTC/JCDC Coach Certificate held by 8,000 coaches, he's co-author of three books, six film series, and the Who You Are Matters! ([www.onelifetools.com](http://www.onelifetools.com)) game; Chief Scientist to [www.youscience.com](http://www.youscience.com); thought leader for [www.lifereimagined.org](http://www.lifereimagined.org); and Advisory Board Member for National University of Singapore's Center for Future Ready Students <http://nus.edu.sg/cfg/>. He has consulted on six continents, all 50 US states and six Canadian provinces.



Rich's interactive and video enhanced presentation connects the essential relationship between career counseling and mental health. It proposes and demonstrates how to help clients develop a HEROIC mindset essential to navigating a lifetime of transitions.
