Being firmly grounded in ethical standards is critical for the delivery of effective service by Professional Counselors. Standards delineated by the American Counseling Association and the NM Counseling and Therapy Practice Board describe best practices. Adherence to an ethical structure contributes to protection of clients as well as the community at large. But in addition, careful attention to the concepts embodied in the codes contributes to the mental health of the counselor her/himself.

Upon completion of the workshop, participants will:

- Be familiar with the current Ethical Standards of the American Counseling Association.
- Be able to identify common areas of ethical challenge in their own practice setting.
- Be aware of their own personal style and the ethical challenges that style creates.
- Identify current trends in the evolution of ethical standards in the counseling profession.
- Be familiar with the community nature of ethical definitions.

Join Dr. Suzanne Schmidt as she explores how behaving in an ethical fashion is as protective of the counselor as the client. This workshop will include a variety of activities designed to clarify the boundaries of ethical behavior. Time will be allotted for discussion of current ethical dilemmas confronting participants.

Dr. Schmidt is an LPCC, LMFT. She has been in private practice for over 35 years. She served as a public school teacher and counselor, as well as a counselor educator. She is an author and former commentator for her local public radio station.
