The purpose of this workshop will be to present clinical supervision models that can be applied by counseling professionals in a variety of settings. This workshop will introduce participants to topics of interest in supervision related to both clinical mental and school counselors. Different models of clinical supervision based on setting (e.g., mental health and school counseling) will be introduced, as well as an Ethical Model of Decision Making, and how that can be applied to supervisory issues. Participants will role play and demonstrate supervision skills to ensure they have the skills to practice clinical supervision following the session.

Upon completion of the workshop, participants will:

- Learn three supervision models that they can implement with their supervisees
- Explore how supervision models can be employed to include a multicultural focus
- Be able to identify supervision models from different traditions and appropriateness in intervening based on supervisees needs.

Kristopher Goodrich, PhD, LPCC, ACS. Dr. Goodrich is an Associate Professor in the Counselor Education program at the University of New Mexico. His academic interests and areas of research include LGBTQQIA issues in professional counseling and counselor education, counselor education pedagogy, and group work in counseling. Dr. Goodrich is serves as Editor for the Journal for Specialists in Group Work and is President-Elect of the Association for Counselor Education and Supervision and the New Mexico Counseling Association.
